



Stanly County Emergency Services is accepting applications for full-time EMT-Basic and Paramedic positions.

Stanly County Emergency Services provides advanced care to the citizens and visitors of Stanly County. Our service works a 24/48 hr. shift with five EMT-Paramedic units and one QRV Paramedic unit. Our service covers the entire county of approximately 400 sq. miles and is bordered by Badin Lake and Lake Tillery with an estimated population of 60,000. Approximately 8,800 calls per year with aggressive protocols to include: RSI, 12 lead EKG, CPAP and Capnography

We also have a competitive salary range system which allows advances into higher pay grades.

Requirements:

Graduation from high school or GED. Must possess and maintain a valid NC driver's license. Must currently be credentialed by NCOEMS as an EMT-P. All Paramedics must be current in BLS, ACLS, BTLs and PALS. All applicants will have to pass a physical, physical agility test and pre-employment drug screening.

40 hour base pay with all hours over 40 time and one half.
