DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES: This grant funded Healthy Beginnings Social Worker position provides education, referrals, and support to pregnant women and their families for up to 2 years postpartum. This position must collaborate with Pregnancy Medical Homes, OB providers, Pediatricians, and other community providers to ensure program goals are being met. This position maintains a caseload of pregnant or interconception women, keeps contact with all program participants, conducts home visits and develops and maintains education sessions. Counsel an assess client needs, develop client centered care plans, make referrals, complete documentation and coordinate services needed by client with other community providers. Participate in community health fairs, educational seminars and assist in promoting programs. Acts as a liaison with local providers and encourages referrals to the program. Track and enter data into Healthy Beginnings data base.

MINIMUM TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS: Bachelor's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work; Bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university and one year directly related experience; Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and two years directly related experience. Position requires computer skills and good communication skills; ability to be extremely flexible, work independently, work as part of a team and possess good decision making skills. Thorough knowledge of and skills in the application of social work theory, practices, principles and techniques employed in the field of public health and related programs. Considerable knowledge of and ability to apply principles and practices of public health; strong knowledge base in maternal, postpartum, and child development issues, medical conditions, disorders and community resources; ability to plan and work collaboratively with community partners.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have valid NC driver's license and reliable transportation. All applicants tentatively selected for this position will be required to submit to a urinalysis to screen for illegal drug use. A criminal records check and a driver's license check will be conducted. Must be flexible in work hours.
