

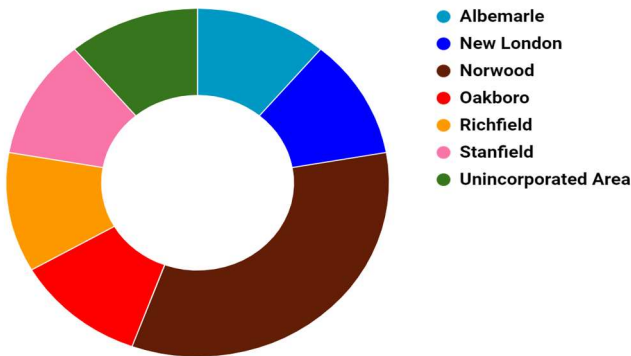

Economic Development Update

The current number of active projects with activity in the past six (6) months is nine (9). One formerly active project recently announced the investment of \$1.5 million and the creation of 8 new jobs in Oakboro. Additionally, there were two (2) new active projects added in the past 30 days.

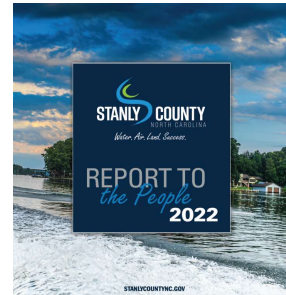
Staff responded to four (4) Requests for Information (RFIs) in the past 30 days. One of these leads was generated by the Charlotte Regional Business Alliance (CRBA), and the other three (3) leads were generated by the Economic Development Partnership of North Carolina (EDPNC).

Jail Overcrowding Update

As of Friday, April 28, there are currently nine (9) inmates being housed out-of-county due to overcrowding in the jail facility. Below please find a summary of the monthly charges the County has incurred for housing inmates out-of-county due to overcrowding in FY 2022-2023.

The average number of inmates booked per day (3.6) is still less than FY 20-21 (3.97) when there was no overcrowding issue.
