# Jail Overcrowding Update

Below please find a summary of the monthly charges the County has incurred for housing inmates out-of-county due to overcrowding in FY 2023-2024.

Please note, some inmates are sent to the Central Prison in Raleigh for "safe-keeping" or medical reasons. These inmates have been excluded from the out-of-county expense data below, given Stanly County budgets for these inmates that require "safe-keeping" or special medical attention on an annual basis.

| December 2023       | \$29,320              |
| January 2024        | \$41,365              |
| February 2024       | \$136,964             |
| March 2024(to date) | \$15,900              |
| TOTAL (FYTD)        | \$275,559             |

As context, below please find a chart with the total inmates booked into the Jail facility and the average daily population between July and February the past five (5) fiscal years.


| Fiscal Year<br>(July-Feb) | Total Booked | Average Daily Jail<br>Population |
|---------------------------|--------------|----------------------------------|
| FY 2019-2020              | 1,508        | 149.8                            |
| FY 2020-2021              | 986          | 125.7                            |
| FY 2021-2022              | 1,019        | 158.8                            |
| FY 2022-2023              | 864          | 145.2                            |
| FY 2023-2024              | 990          | 134.5                            |

An interesting data point to highlight is the fact that our average daily population is considerably less this year, but our out-of-county charges are higher. It would seem more inmates could be housed at our facility instead of putting them in beds out of county.

### **Property Tax Collections Update**

As of February 29 the real property tax collection rate was 96.57%. This rate is 0.58 percentage points higher than the reported rate at the end of February 2023.
